# THE KALALAU TRAIL

**This is a video game, not a navigation aid or guide.  
It is not to scale and is not representative of real life.**

**The real Kalalau Trail is much harder, much more  
dangerous, and much, much more beautiful!**

The real Kalalau Trail is on the Hawaiian island of Kaua'i.

This map shows the general route of the Kalalau Trail. The Trail starts at Ke'e Beach, hits an intersection at Hanakapi'ai Beach, and then continues either inland to Hanakapi'ai Falls, or along the coast to Kalalau Beach. Both routes are part of the game.



As you explore the Trail, look for discarded water bottles, Recycle all 11 to complete the adventure.





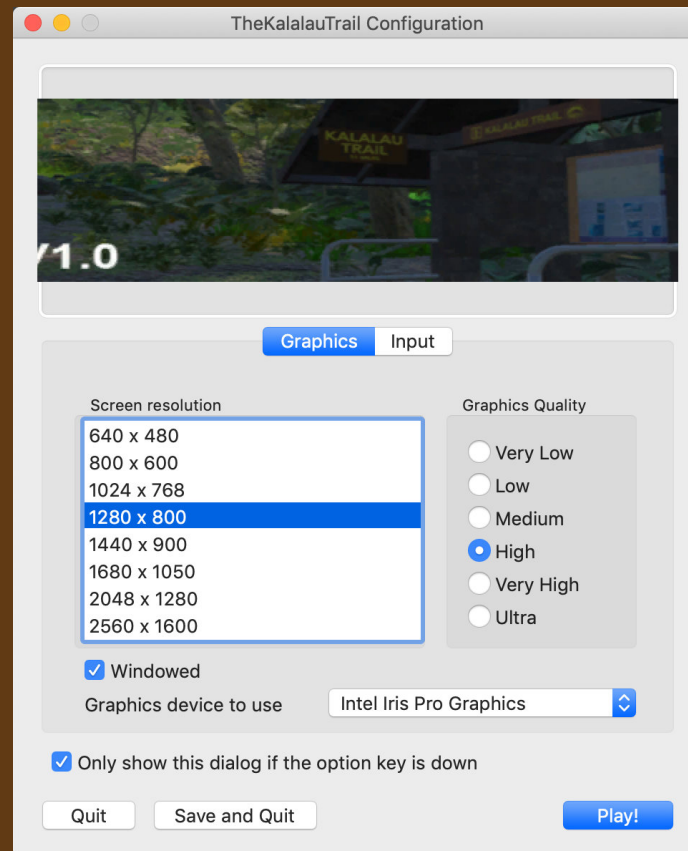
You control your hiking character's movement using your mouse and the keys on your keyboard. You can get a reminder of these keys by hitting "esc" at any time on your keyboard.

**Use your mouse or trackpad to look around**

<b>Move Forward</b>		
<b>W</b>		
<b>Move Left</b>	<b>Jump!</b>	<b>Move Right</b>
<b>A</b>	<b>space</b>	<b>D</b>
<b>Move Backwards</b>		
<b>S</b>		
<b>Hold SHIFT to run</b>		

Pick up a water bottle by clicking on it.

The Kalalau Trail puts a lot of demand on your computer, due to the large amount of plants on the actual trail. If your computer runs too slowly, you can reduce the resolution or quality settings used by the game. To access these settings, press "ALT" (Mac) or "CTRL" (PC) while starting the game. You can also increase the resolution and quality settings if your computer can keep up.
